
Tree paste

Biodynamic tree paste is a very important preparation that is painted or sprayed on the trunks and larger branches of trees. It is a biodynamic insight that the bark of perennial trees and vines is quite similar to the surface of the soil where compost might be applied.

Biodynamic Paste

A nourishing, healing concentrate, made for use on trees, shrubs, vines and roses.





- ▶ Discourages the growth of fungi, lichen and scale
- ▶ Deters harmful insects, including borers, from damaging the trunk or sheltering amongst crevices in bark
- ► Reduces transplant shock
- ► Promotes wound healing
- ► Use as a dip for bare rooted plants to stimulate root growth and enable speedy establishment

Enlightened agriculture conference


