

Hello everyone,

Probably the most important aspect of Steiner's gifts to agriculture concern the hidden qualities of water, especially its ability to respond to applied energies and how best to utilise them in stimulating soil fertility and the growing of plants.

In the spring edition of News Leaf we have emphasised the importance of structuring the water used to dilute the increasingly popular Liquid Soil Activator (LSA). This is a powerful omnibus of all the eight preps, Winter Horn Clay and other natural ingredients. We now offer this in 100ml bottles, a suitable size for gardens and smaller areas.

Even if one cannot employ a set of flowforms to avoid the detriment of using unstructured diluting water, there is the option of an inline water structuring system such as one of the Phion devices. Powerful magnets and internal vortexing impart a negative charge to the water, erasing its "memories" and making it receptive to the biodynamic messaging of LSA.

What is structured water and why we recommend it?

This is the most important requirement for potentiating the soil and atmospheric preparations and for diluting Liquid Soil Activator (LSA). This is that the "good water" must be STRUCTURED, meaning that its memories need to be cancelled or neutralised so that it is receptive to the biodynamic messages contained in the highly energised preparations, as well as their combination, LSA.

for us in our daily practical activities."*





What are biodynamic peppers?

Biodynamic peppers are an organic, non-toxic method for controlling animals, weeds and insects that have become a pest. The peppers are created by burning the weed, insect or animal to create an ash. This ash is potentized using homeopathic procedures.

By creating an ash, the energy of the pest animal or plant is severed. This works on the principle that water creates life and fire extinguishes life.

How are peppers used?

The peppers are dispersed during the full moon by stirring 10 drops of the pepper into a bucket of rain water. The mixture is stirred for 10 minutes before being dispersed over the area where the animal or weed is to be controlled.

The peppers are very specific and only work to control the specific pest animal, insect or weed. This means separate peppers are required for each animal, plant or insect.

Can peppers be mixed together?


The peppers work by tuning in to the energy of the specific animal, plant or insect. It is recommended the peppers not be mixed, but be dispersed separately.

Paper Wasp, 28 Spot Ladybeetle, Flea Beetle, Hard Scale, Bronze Citrus Bug, Green/Brown Grasshopper, Fruit fly

Animal and Bird Peppers:

Rat, Mouse, Ringtail Possum, Brushtail possum, Brush Turkey, Noisy Miner, Indian Myna, Silver Eye, Cane Toad, Crow, Corella, Cockatoo

Weed Peppers:

Commelina cyanea, Cobblers pegs, Velcro weed, Singapore Daisy, Oxalis (Pink flower), Nutgrass, Catsears

Rain Plus* - Sequential Spray Kit

With an extended dry period on the way (El Nino) we recommend applying our Rain Plus - Sequential Spray Kit. This is a sequential spray kit containing all nine of the biodynamic preparations which are sprayed out in a short period of time – from 12-36 hours. This sequential application, over three days, can promote rainfall by rebalancing the local atmosphere.

* The converse can result in a lessening of rain at flood times. The sprayed hectare also receives a strong benefit.

A series of soil and atmospheric sprays are put out over three successive days when the Moon is in a water sign and preferably near Full Moon and the best dates to do this are:

29 September to 1 October
26-28 October

22-24 November




